She is engaged in **Cottbus**, where she sings Amneris, „Siegfried“ und "Rheingold" Erda, 1° Norne and Waltraute in "Götterdämmerung", Hänsel, „Verdi Requiem“, Olga, Niklas in "Hofmann" and Jezibaba in „Rusalka“.
