

Kiril MANOLOV Baritone

Kiril Manolov Todorov (artistic name: Kiril Manolov) was born in Sofia, where he studied singing at the Conservatory.

He was prize holder of various singing competitions in Bulgaria, but also in Budapest, Warsaw, Barcelona, Finland, Korea and Brescia.

His operatic debut took place at the Conservatory in Sofia as Masetto.

In Bulgaria he could be heard in Sofia, Varna, Rousse, Stara Sagora, Plovdiv and Burgos, where he sang very successfully roles such as Nabucco, Renato, Germont, Luna, Posa, Sharpless, Marcello, Don Giovanni, „Lucia“ Enrico, „Barbiere di Siviglia“ Figaro, Escamillo, Silvio, Valentin, Alfio.

He appeared a.o. as Enrico and Gianni Schicchi in Sofia, Belcore in Plovdiv, Simone Boccanegra, Amonasro, Nabucco, Marcello, Enrico and Belcore in Split, Nabucco at the festival in Gars am Kamp and in Brno, Germont in Belgrad and Palma Mallorca, Renato in „Ballo in maschera“ in Tokyo, Figaro in „Barbiere di Siviglia“, Renato, Dandini and Falstaff in Zagreb, and the new productions of „Falstaff“ and "Gianni Schicchi“ at the opera house in Wiesbaden.

Last contracts till 2015 include Luna in „Trovatore“ in Cologne, Falstaff in Hannover, Miller in „Luisa Miller“ in Essen, Falstaff at Staatsoper Hamburg, Germont at Festival in Solothurn and Falstaff in Wuppertal. Further he sang Nabucco in Timisoara, Falstaff in Budapest, Zagreb, Varna and Lucca, Amonasro in Nuremberg, Dulcamara and Figaro in "Barbiere di Siviglia" in Zagreb and Amonasro in Sofia.

In Wiesbaden he was heard as Falstaff, Simone Boccanegra, Don Pasquale, Amonasro, Carlo in "Forza del destino", Miller in „Luisa Miller“, Figaro in „Barbiere di Siviglia“ and in "Love of the three oranges" and "Aufstieg und Fall der Stadt Mahagonny".

Recent contracts till 2018 he is singing his first Ford in Piacenza, his first Jago and Gerard in Varna, Falstaff in Savona, Ferrara and Deutsche Oper Berlin, "Forza del destino" in Parma, Nabucco in Trieste, Amonasro, Gianni Schicchi/Michele in Rome, Sharpless in Las Palmas, Falstaff at Festival Martina Franca, with Mo. Muti in Ravenna and at Festival Savonlinna, "Corsaro" in Parma, Nabucco in Stuttgart, Simone Boccanegra in Antwerpen and Piacenza and Rigoletto in Savonlinna.

2019 he will sing Amonasro in Chicago with Mo. Muti.
