Katja Starke is born in Pirna, she studied in Würzburg and joined the Opera Studio at the Zurich Opera right after obtaining her degree in singing.

She was a member of the ensemble at the Opera St. Gallen, where she was heard in roles like Adalgisa, Hänsel, Donna Elvira, Christine in Sutermeister's "The Black Spider", Sonjietka in "Lady Macbeth of Mzensk", as well as in the title role of "Carmen" and Offenbach's "La Périchole".

She performed concerts with Filharmonia Lodz, Sinfonie Orchester St. Gallen, Kammerorchester St. Gallen, Sinfonie Orchester Basel and Filarmonica Arturo Toscanini in Parma, she has worked with conductors like Antonello Allemandi, Frederic Chaslin, Jiri Kout, Ion Marin, Carlo Rizzi, David Stern, Yuri Termirkanov and Franz Welser-Möst.

Last roles that she performed in St. Gallen include Ulrica, 3^o Dame, Komponist, Maddalena in "Rigoletto", Marguerite in "Damnation di Faust" and Orlovsky.

Recent and future guest contracts until 2019/20 comprise "Mozart Requiem" in Parma, Suzuki and Tisbe at Opera Zurich, "Verdi Requiem" in Lichtenstein, Erda in "Rheingold" and "Siegfried" and Kabanicha in "Katia Kabanova" in Dijon, "Verdi Requiem" and Ulrica in Hannover, "Missa Solemnis" in Basel and "Verdi Requiem" in Würzburg. She sings Principessa in "Suor Angelica", 3^o Dame, Eboli, Rheingold Erda as well as "Charlotte Salomon" and "L'incoronazione di Poppea" in Bielefeld and Kabanicha in "Katia Kabanova" and Madame de Croissy in "Dialogues des Carmélites" and in Aachen.
