

## **Anton KEREMIDTCHIEV Baritone**

Anton Keremidtchiev was born in Bulgaria but has got the Italian citizenship. He studied singing at the Conservatory in Sofia and also with Boris Christoff, he was twice finalist of the Competition "Toti dal Monte" in Treviso.

He started his career as a bass in Sofia and in Leipzig and sang as a guest also at Teatro Verdi in **Trieste**, Teatro Massimo in **Palermo**, at Rossini Opera Festival in **Pesaro**, in **Treviso**, **Paris**, **Valencia**, **Oviedo** und **Moscow**.

Then he changed his repertoire, his first role as a baritone was Jago.

Mr. Keremidtchiev was heard at Komische Oper **Berlin** as Germont, Sharpless and Pizarro, at Finish National Opera in **Helsinki** as Escamillo, at Staatsoper **Hamburg** as Germont, in **Frankfurt** as Kurwenal, in **Dortmund** as Telramund, in **Leipzig** as Kurwenal and Count in „Nozze di Figaro“, in **Wels** as Klingsor and Heerrufer as well as to the theatres in **Cologne**, **Düsseldorf**, **Mannheim** and **Bonn** as Escamillo and Jago.

He sang Escamillo in **Helsinki**, Amonasro in **Kiel** and **Münster**, Kurwenal in **Leipzig**, Germont and Pizarro in **Berlin**, Telramund in **Dortmund**, Pizarro at Komische Oper **Berlin**, Rigoletto and Ford at the Festival in **Herrenchiemsee**, Kurwenal in **Hong Kong**, Amfortas in **Budapest**, Macbeth at Deutsche Oper **Berlin**, Klingsor in **Wels** and **Zagreb** and Telramund in **Toulon**.
