

## **Emilio PONS Tenor**

Emilio Pons is born in Mexico, he holds a graduate degree in Piano from the National Conservatory of Music in Mexico and a Juris Doctor Degree from the Universidad Iberoamericana, in addition to a Master and Doctor of Music Degree from the Indiana University Jacobs School of Music.

He is a prize winner of the Pavel Lisitsian Competition in 2006 and Belvedere Competition in Vienna in 2007, moreover, he also won a prize at the competition at Palm Beach Opera.

He studied in Russia as well and made his professional debut at the Mariinsky Theater in **St. Petersburg**.

His international career brought him to important theatres like Grand Théâtre **Geneva**, Royal Opera House **Copenhagen**, the Vlaamse Opera in **Ghent** and **Antwerp**, to the Opera Festival in **St. Margarethen**, Austria, to Kammeroper in **Vienna**, to Prinzregententheater in **Munich**, to Deutsche Oper am Rhein in **Düsseldorf**, to **Bayreuth**, **Freiburg**, **Heidelberg**, **Vilnius**, Opéra de **Metz**, France, to Opera de Bellas Artes in **Mexico City**, to Teatro Municipal of **Santiago de Chile** and to Teatro Municipal of **Rio de Janeiro**, with roles like Tamino, Ferrando, Don Ottavio, Almaviva, Nemorino, Narraboth, Chevalier de la Force, Lenski and many others.

He sang Don Ottavio and Narraboth in **Wuppertal**, Pedrillo at Opéra de **Metz**, Tom Rakewell in "Rake's Progress" in **Braunschweig**, "Stabat Mater" by Rossini in **Bern**, "Salome" in **Bogota** as well as Lenski in **Coburg**, **Vilnius** and **St. Gallen**.
